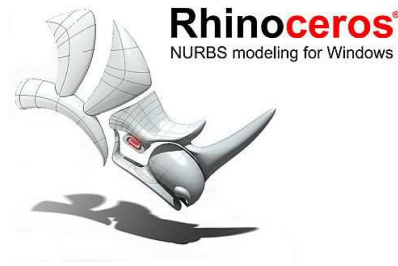


Rhino3D Level 2 @ NDAR, Antibes, 18-20 January 2016

Course fees are 650€ / day, lunch will be provided. Advance payment of the fee is required to confirm registration. A minimum of 2 registered attendees is requested to confirm the course.

Participants should have Rhino3D v5 installed on their laptops. A temporary licence may be borrowed for the time of the training. In terms of hardware, any modern laptop or netbook will run Rhino5 comfortably in the context of the training course.

Registration will be accepted on a first come first served basis, places are limited.
